Welcome to the Westfield High School Class Registration System for 2015-2016

Before registering for classes, please read the course descriptions in the course book thoroughly! Also pay attention to the notes here on this page. You need to choose 15 credits (2 trimester courses are 2 credits) and 2 Alternates. The alternates HAVE to be chosen in the last section, titled 10th Grade Alternates. If you are going to take PE II online this summer, you do not need to choose it here.

**10th Grade Required English** Click the edit button to request a course

Every 10th grader must take either English 10-384, English 10-3A, 3B&4A, or English 10-384 Honors.

**10th Grade Required Math** Click the edit button to request a course

All 10th graders must take math. We offer two trimester & three trimester Algebra I, Geometry & Algebra II. Read the math comments carefully as you choose your courses.

**10th Grade Science Classes** Click the edit button to request a course

Please choose ALL the science classes you intend to take next year. All sophomores should take a minimum of two science classes towards your requirements (i.e. ICP, Biology, Chemistry or Physics).

**10th Grade Required PE II** Click the edit button to request a course

All 10th grade students need to take PE II if you plan to take it through Indiana Online Academy this summer; you do not need to choose it here. However,

## Important Reminders

- All 10<sup>th</sup> graders must take *English 10, Math and Science*
- You must have 2 credits of *World History* or *Geography & History of the World* to graduate. Add it to 10<sup>th</sup> grade if you have not taken it yet.
- *PE II and Adv. Health/Elective PE* are graduation requirements.
- Tell your counselor if you plan to take Summer Classes through IOA.
- Talk to your teachers and parents about your schedule. They are great resources for you!

## Requesting Your Classes in Power School

- Use Chrome, Safari or Mozilla (NOT Internet Explorer) to log into your Power School Account
- Click on the **Class Registration** link on the left
- Follow directions carefully to select classes
- You will select **17 total credits**: 15 credits + 2 alternate credits
- Add your 2 alternate credits in the section at the bottom titled, "Alternates"
- Hit Submit when you are done, and print out your course requests
