*When is it?*

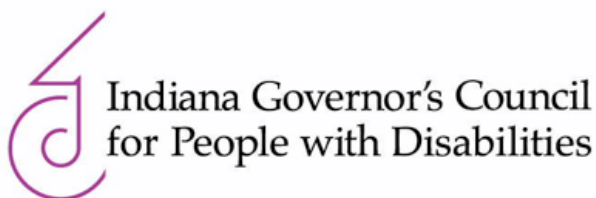
