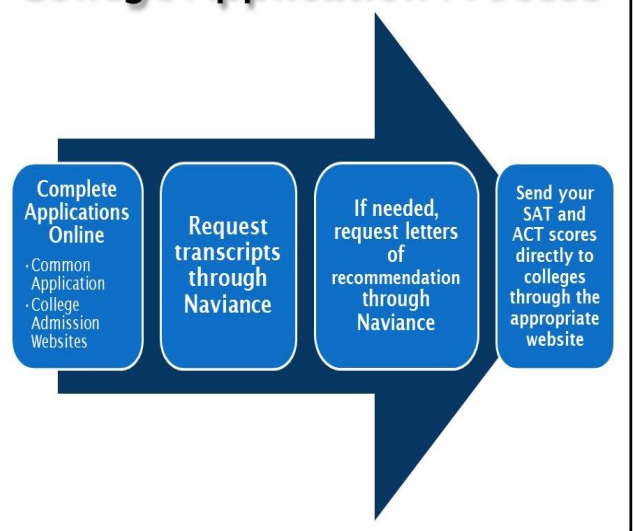


## PSAT Testing at WHS on October 10, 2018
