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COMMUNITY PROFILE & ENROLLMENT DATA

Westfield High School is a public high school located in Westfield, Indiana. It's a rapidly growing community 20 miles north of downtown Indianapolis. Westfield High School is accredited by the Indiana Department of Education.

Enrollment for 2018-2019 is 2,397 with 538 seniors, 575 juniors, 590 sophomores and 685 freshmen. The faculty consists of 130 licensed staff. Eighty percent of our licensed staff have a masters degree or higher.

CURRICULUM

Westfield High School is on a trimester schedule. Class periods are 70 minutes long and meet five days per week. Each trimester is 12 weeks long. Classes are one trimester, two trimesters or three trimesters in length. Students receive one credit per trimester for each course successfully completed. Students have an opportunity to earn fifteen credits each year. Westfield High School offers 30 AP classes and 20 dual-credit courses this year. Dual-credit opportunities are offered through Indiana University's ACP program and Ivy Tech.

RECOGNITION

Westfield High School has been recognized by the Indiana Department of Education for excellence and access in the Advanced Placement program. For the past eight years, students have met participation and exceeded success goals. Sixty-four percent of the class of 2018 attained a score of three and higher on Advanced Placement examinations.

AP CAPSTONE DIPLOMA

The AP Capstone Diploma, conferred by the College Board, is an innovative and prestigious diploma program that gives students an opportunity to apply critical thinking, collaborative problem solving, and research skills in a cross-curricular context. Westfield High School was one of five schools in Indiana, and one of 150 high schools nationally, to pilot this program. The Class of 2016 was the first WHS class to earn this nationally recognized diploma.
