Life as a Cadet

- Military Science Classroom:
Freshman – 1 cr. Meets once a week
Sophomores – 2 cr. Meets once a week
Junior/Senior – 3 cr. Meets twice a week
- Physical training (PT) – 0645-0800 Mon/Wed
Leadership Lab – 0645 – 0900 Friday
- Spring/Fall Field Training – One 4 day weekend per semester

Optional training/opportunities:

Airborne School, Air Assault School, Mountain Warfare School, Sapper, Ranger Challenge, Norwegian Road March, German Proficiency, Language Training, Cultural Exchange, Intramural Sports, Nurse Summer Training Program, etc.

National Scholarship

- Apply after Feb of Junior year and before 10 Jan of Senior year
- To apply:

- 4 year scholarship or 3 year Advance Designee
- Criteria:
 - Min 2.5 GPA
 - US Citizen
 - 920 SAT/19 ACT
 - Pass Army Physical
 - Pass Fitness Test
 - Under 31 years old at time of commissioning (can be waived)
- Not based on financial need

Campus Based Scholarship

- Apply after 10 Jan of Senior year
- 4, 3, & 2 year scholarship or 3 year Advance Designee
- To apply: contact ROTC department at your university to begin process
- Criteria:
 - Min 2.5 GPA
 - US Citizen
 - 920 SAT/19 ACT
 - Pass Army Physical
 - Pass Fitness Test
 - Under 31 years old at time of commissioning (can be waived)
- Not based on financial need
- Benefits are the same as National Scholarship

National/Campus Based Scholarships

1. 100% Tuition and mandatory fees
2. \$1200 per year for books (paid to student)
3. \$420.00 monthly stipend (paid to student)

Obligations

Regardless of the entry option, there is an 8 year commitment which begins upon commissioning. The component in which the new Lieutenant serves determines how the time is divided.

Active Duty Scholarship Option: 4 years active, 4 years IRR

Active Duty Non-Scholarship: 3 years active, 5 years IRR

Reserves: 6 years drilling status, 2 years IRR
