Hoosier Boys State gives young men a great opportunity to not only learn, but experience how our government operates. Students will be able to apply and increase their knowledge of the state and local government with hundreds of the top students from the state of Indiana. Past delegates have reported their week at Boys State to be a “life changing” experience that has taught them to be more aware of their role as a United States citizen. It is an honor to be selected for Hoosier Boys State, and many colleges give special consideration for admission and scholarships to former delegates.

Eligibility

Delegates must be a junior in high school, and have a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher. They must demonstrate leadership abilities, be honest and possess good character. Two delegates will be chosen to represent Westfield High School. If selected, delegates must agree to stay for the entire week, barring any emergencies. The cost for the week is paid for by the American Legion.

Application

Please fill out the attached application and return to the School Counseling Center by February 1, 2019

You and your parent must both sign the application, indicating that you will be available to attend the entire Boys State from June 16-21, 2019.

The selected WHS delegates and alternate will be notified by February 8, 2019. The chosen delegates and alternate must complete an official American Legion Hoosier Boys State application which must be signed by a parent. **A waiver of liability and doctor’s statement/signature or IHSA physical is also required. Boys should also plan on attending an Orientation Session prior to attending the program in June.**
