### **Eligibility**

Delegates must currently be a junior in high school, and have a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher. They must demonstrate leadership abilities, be honest and possess good character. Two delegates will be chosen to represent Westfield High School. If selected, delegates must agree to stay for the entire week, barring any emergencies. The cost for the week is paid for by the Westfield Lions Club.

### **Application**

***You and your parent must both sign the application, indicating that you will be available to attend the entire Hoosier Girls State from June 23-29, 2019.***

Students will be notified by February 1, 2019 if they have been selected as a delegate or alternate for Westfield High School. Delegates and alternates must then complete a separate form for the American Legion Auxiliary.
