



Virtual Learning Guidelines for Westfield High School in 2020-2021

Students may opt-into Virtual Learning for the 2020-2021 school year. Westfield High School is offering Virtual Learning through the Edmentum platform. Courses are aligned to Indiana academic standards and the high school curriculum. The lessons, activities, and assessments are all delivered through the virtual learning platform and students can pace their learning based on their own schedules and mastery of each lesson.

WWS teachers will be assigned to support students through their learning by answering questions, helping students monitor their progress, and providing extension activities as needed but will not actually be designing or delivering the lessons.

- Students who opt-into the Virtual Learning program are committing to working in Edmentum through the remainder of the trimester. Students may elect to move back into in-person hybrid classes at the start of the next trimester. A short grace period at the start of the school year will be allowed in order for families to make the decision that is best for them. Please see the deadline below.
- Should circumstances arise that force all hybrid in-person classes to move to online eLearning, students working in Edmentum will continue to work in Edmentum for the remainder of the trimester.
- Students will choose up to 5 classes from the Edmentum Course Catalog, and will work with their High School Counselor to select the most appropriate classes.
- All classes taken in Edmentum should be completed by the end of the trimester. Students will receive a final grade for each course they are registered for, using the same grading scale as hybrid in-person classes at WHS. Any incomplete work at the end of the trimester will be counted as a zero toward the final grade.
- Student Athletes must be enrolled in and pass at least 4 classes in Edmentum each trimester in order to remain academically eligible for athletics.
